

Summary

Sculpting Neon will be taught by renowned London based German glass maker <u>Jochen Holz</u>, with support from <u>Neon Workshops</u>. The 3-day neon class will use borosilicate glass to push the 3D sculptural potential of gas-filled glass. Jochen's own design approach is led by the making process, and the subtle flow of hot glass, as he navigates the possibilities and restrictions of the technique and material. And in the same organic, fun and exploratory approach, the class schedule will flow.

We are excited and privileged to be working from the studio of celebrated Porto ceramicist <u>Joao Carqueijeiro</u>, Jochen will be joined in the beautiful city of Porto by Neon Workshops, as we encourage unconventional outcomes in glass and neon!

Aims and aspirations

Neon making can be time-consuming and difficult. There are real time constraints here, and this isn't the class to make a masterpiece, rather a rare introduction into something that you may wish to continue exploring with a master glass maker, supported by neon experts. We measure success by you leaving fully intact, with something – whether physical or vital knowledge and experience - that inspires and reminds you of a rewarding and memorable experience during your time with us.

Your work

Depending on how far you push experimentations and abilities, you may or may not leave with a working handmade gas-filled glass neon. However everyone will leave with a niche and extraordinary experience, that may never happen again.

Things to bring with you

- . Non-flammable clothing, jeans and cotton is ideal.
- . Safe footwear, no open toed sandals
- . Camera and/or documenting method.
